Internationally recognised as a beacon for hope, Coventry Cathedral is an inspirational space for reflection.

The *Belgrade Theatre* is a major arts and cultural facility in Coventry and remains one of the largest regional production theatres in Britain. The theatre offers a diverse and exciting production programme ranging from touring musicals to critically acclaimed plays and traditional pantomimes – something for the entire family.



Discover the fascinating story behind the development of British road vehicles at *Coventry Transport Museum* which houses some of the most unique vehicles ever invented.

*St Mary's Guildhall* is one of the finest surviving guildhalls in England, an unexpected treasure in the narrow, winding lanes of Coventry's historic Cathedral Quarter. First built in the 1340s, the magnificent Great Hall, stained glass windows, carved ceilings and rare tapestry combine to offer a fascinating insight to Coventry's medieval past.



Dating back almost 1,000 years, the beginnings of *Holy Trinity Church* are tied to the Benedictine Priory of St Mary which has long been associated to the Earl of Leofric and Lady Godiva herself. Holy Trinity welcomes visitors to explore the church's fascinating past and view its exceptional medieval painting of the Last Judgement, recently restored and on full public display.
