

Weekend trips to Dudley borough - the heart of the Black Country

Whether it's exploring the wealth of heritage in the Stourbridge Glass Quarter, or discovering what life would have been like here in the Black Country at the height of the industrial revolution, there's plenty to see and do in Dudley borough. Whatever the size of your group, we can offer personal guided tours and a tailor made package at our visitor attractions to suit your needs.

Package one: Leg it to Dudley Holiday code DD1 Friday to Saturday (1 night) or Saturday to Sunday (1 night)

Explore the fascinating caverns and limestone mines underneath Dudley on this 45 minute skipper guided boat trip, then choose to enjoy refreshments, a meal or afternoon tea in the canal-side Gongoozler restaurant or aboard dining boat Vic Smallshire. Spend the rest of your day at the Black Country Living Museum where you'll discover 300 years of history like no other. Explore the canalside villages and once you've worked up an appetite, discover culinary delights of the past with a bag of 1930s-style fish & chips or a pint from the Bottle & Glass Inn. Don't forget to visit their new high street and take in the sights and sounds of the 1940s-60s!

Package two: Glass and the Past Holiday code DD2 Friday to Saturday (1 night)

A guided tour around the heart of the Glass Quarter attractions including Ruskin Glass Centre and Glasshouse Heritage Centre (both in the same location), the Red House Glass Cone and Stourbridge Glass Museum that proudly hosts a globally significant glass collection alongside interactive digital displays. The Museum is also home to artist Allister Malcolm's Hot Glass Making Studio where you can see glass making in action. Glassblowing demonstrations offered at all sites, check websites for details. Or maybe you wish to see The Lace Guild situated within the Stourbridge Glass Quarter housing a large collection of lace items and artefacts.

Lunch is available in the organic cafe at the Ruskin Glass Centre, or the Red Cone Coffee House at the Red House Glass Cone. Please choose which venue you would like to take lunch at and pre-book in advance.

All group tours are by pre-arrangement and must be booked in advance.
